



CONSENT FOR USE OF CHILDREN'S ADVIL 2011 - 2012

For the protection of all children, we ask that you keep your child home if they have a temperature of 101 degrees or more. If your child develops a fever while at our center, the parent or guardian will be notified to pick the child up as soon as possible. In the event that a parent or guardian cannot be reached, or is unavailable to pick up the child immediately, the director or acting director will administer an age appropriate dose of "Children's Advil" if the consent is signed. The director will not administer any Advil unless the child's fever goes above 102 degrees, as recommended by most pediatricians. When you arrive to pick up your child, you will be given a "Medication Administered" form for your signature.

I hereby give my permission to the Planet Kid's director or acting director to administer an age appropriate dose of "Children's Advil" to my child under the circumstances described above.
